GOING TO FATHER'S HOUSE

A DREAM

The Lord reminded me of a dream I had in January of 2001- That was the year of the 911 attack on the twin towers of New-York City, and the beginning of many changes for this country and for the world.

In the dream, *"I was standing with a friend in the side aisle of a large meeting place, like a church. Suddenly and quickly the place filled up with men all dressed up in suits and ties. I knew that they were all ministers of the Word. Then I was told that I was the speaker and that the service was beginning right away. This took me completely by surprise and panic struck my heart. I had not prepared for such a thing but I knew that I had to go ahead with it. Then I felt the Spirit say to me, "Just begin with 'LET NOT YOUR HEARTS BE TROUBLED" and I will give you the rest as you go." And so it was.*" (End of dream).

At first, the interpretation of this dream seemed obvious, but as time went by the Spirit began to develop more on the full meaning of this word. Looking back I realize that it was from the time I received this dream that the Lord began to unfold a specific word that His ministers needed to hear. As the dream shows, they were all dressed in suits and ties, in other words, they had been made ready to hear and move on. That Word begins with "LET NOT YOUR HEARTS BE TROUBLED."

Shortly after that dream, beginning with the events of 911, we have been witnesses of one tragedy after

another as nations crumble and the powers of this world try to stop the vortex that is sucking them into a pit of violence and destruction. At the same time, nature is rising up with fury on all continents and the entire civilization is spinning out of control.

In view of all this, ministers of God's word are themselves short of knowing the answer and they are flooding Christians with mixed messages of judgment and repentance. Of course there is always a need for such, but it just is not THE word that God is sending to His people today. I declare to you by the Word of the Lord that God's message for all must begin with, "**LET NOT YOUR HEARTS BE TROUBLED.**"

Jesus first spoke this Word when He was preparing to physically leave His troubled disciples. They needed to know that He was not leaving them orphans, He had much more to say to them and He was providing for them to hear Him by His Spirit.

When the Lord spoke to the churches of Asia, He made sure to say, *"He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches."* (Rev.2: 29) The Lord gave us teaching ministries. Paul said that *"...He hath made us **able ministers** of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life."* (II Cor.3: 6)

Ministers of Christ are called to train the people who have an ear (those who have received the bap-

tism in the Holy Spirit) to hear what the Spirit is saying. The letter kills, it does not give life and it does not train one to use their spiritual ear. Many Christians believe in an historical Jesus. They may know the letter by heart, but if you tell them that the Lord really speaks in dreams, visions, prophecies and revelations, they may smile and be polite but they do not really believe it is true.

As we hear with an ear to hear, we believe. The word by the Spirit imparts faith and life. The written word confirms what we hear by the Spirit. *“So faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”* (Rom.10:17)

THE SPOKEN WORD

When God created the heaven and the earth, He spoke the Word. *“AND GOD SAID, LET THERE BE...”* (Gen.1: 3, 6...) God did not stop speaking, *“God who at sundry times, and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the PROPHETS, hath in these last days spoken unto us by HIS SON...”* (Heb.1: 1-2a) The Son Jesus of Nazareth spoke then and the resurrected Jesus is still speaking now.

It is not the WRITTEN WORD that creates and brings the logos to pass; it is the SPOKEN WORD. When Jesus came on the scene, the devils trembled for they knew that His Word was powerful. He was the Word of God made flesh. He was the SPOKEN WORD of God.

The fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil was not an apple; it was the word of the serpent to the carnal mind. The serpent is a created being with a purpose. *“Behold, I have created the smith that bloweth the coals in the fire, and that bringeth forth an instrument for his work; and I have created the waster to destroy.”* (Isa. 54: 16)

There is a difference between the fire that refines and forms us into the instrument that God desires and the work of the waster who destroys all that is fitted unto destruction. The next verse puts us at ease, *“No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against*

thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.” (Vs.17)

By this we understand that the “waster” can only destroy that which is no longer useful to God or to us. He is the “garbage disposal and the sewer system” in God's creation and he has been set among us to do his work. He is very necessary but he has his limits and he knows that his time is short. God used him to do a work in Job but he could only do what God permitted.

When the waster speaks, he speaks lies and his lies create sin and death. Sin and death are the works of the devil that Jesus destroyed on the cross. *“He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.”* (I Jn.3: 8)

Jesus explained to the Pharisees that their father the devil *“...was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.”* (Jn. 8: 44)

The kingdoms of this world are all the masterpiece of the devil who inspired men with his lies. He speaks words that sound like great wisdom and makes promises of better days ahead, but all are lies. He has set his throne in man's carnal mind so man has believed his lies and cannot recognize truth when they hear it. They have to be born again.

Jesus was the Word made flesh; He spoke directly to the devil. In His wilderness temptations, Jesus was not faced by an evil being with a pitchfork; the devil that Jesus faced was that subtle lying spirit that was trying to manipulate His mind.

Jesus sent His Spirit into our spirit and soul (mind) to overcome the lies of the devil. We overcome him (the devil) by the blood of the Lamb and by THE WORD OF OUR TESTIMONY. Jesus sends His Word to be grafted into our minds and hearts and to withstands and overcome the lies that the devil throws at us daily.

The Old Testament is our witness that through the prophets, God sent His word to the ruling kings of that day. But the rulers killed the prophets. Then for four hundred years, God did not raise one prophet and His word was not heard until the greatest prophet among them appeared in the person of John the Baptist. John's voice cried in the wilderness calling men to repent but again the rulers, whose father is the devil, (he is the one they listen to in their minds) killed John the Baptist as well as the testimony of every true prophet since.

This is why the true church on this side of the veil today is an “underground” church. She is in the world but cannot be detected. She is not physically hidden but God has sheltered her so that the world does not recognize her.

In 1940, France had been conquered by Nazi forces and was under German occupation until 1944 when the American Armies came to deliver Europe. During that time, the French patriot and General Charles De Gaulle was in London England recruiting and organizing what was called “The Free French Forces.”

I lived in Paris during that time and in 1940 I was only ten years old. I heard many things from my father and grandfather too but I never heard anyone speak about Free French Forces. It was in 1944 when the allies had arrived on the coasts of Normandy and were moving in the direction of Paris that the Free French Forces suddenly made their appearance in Paris.

Before the American troops arrived, fierce fighting broke out in the streets of Paris. It was the Free French Forces seemingly coming out of nowhere and putting the German Army to flight. This surprised the Germans and us too. We had to stay home because the streets were not safe. In some areas of Paris the fighting was intense.

The French Forces had been waiting a long time for this. They were determined to get the Germans out of Paris themselves before the American Armies rolled in. As it turned out, the Germans had wired the entire subway system with dynamite ready to

blow up all of Paris by turning on a switch. The FFF knew about it and were able to stop this catastrophe from happening.

By that time I was fourteen years old and I remember it all vividly. Why is this all coming to mind. Because just as the French Forces had been prepared in the midst of the enemy, the Lord has been preparing His church in the midst of the darkness. When the time comes, the sons who have been prepared “underground” will appear and foil the plans of the enemy.

We may not realize this, but we have been strategically placed here and there seemingly alone. We are the “wired” underground church that is ready to stand in the Son. We are the prepared army of God's sons ready to deliver the last blow to the occupying enemy! *Not by might nor by power but by My Spirit saith the Lord!* By the power of His Word made flesh!

The world has no idea of the church that the Lord has been building on the Rock of revelation. The manifestation of the sons of God is the next great event for the world. The spoken Word of God will again be heard in the streets (the ways of man) and bring in the new heaven and earth. Until God releases the sons in the world, there will be no end to the darkness but when the new day dawns the light of the spoken Word of God will reveal the Son in all His glory. The lie will have lost its power and sin and death will be no more.

The Lord is building His church through the spoken word. When the Spirit gives a revelation, He also makes provision for this word to be witnessed between two or three. *“For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.”* (Matt.18: 20) There is no need for large congregation or for expensive buildings when two or three are sufficient. Keep in mind that, by the Spirit, the Father and the Son dwell in us, therefore we always have a sure witness with us.

Some questioned John the Baptist whether he was the promised One. *“And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.”* (Jn.1: 20)

The voice of the prophets was being replaced by the voice of the Son of God. *“And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father) full of grace and truth.”* (Jn.1: 14)

When the Word was made flesh, the Word no longer came second-hand; the spoken Word of God dwelt among us. The world had been waiting for Him but they did not recognize Him. *“He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.”* (Jn.1: 10)

He spoke the word of truth but His people could not receive him. Most of His people still cannot receive Him. They are waiting for a Jesus like the One who came long ago, but they are failing to find Him within themselves yet we know that the entire creation is groaning and travailing to see Him.

God sent the prophets and the world killed the prophets. Then God sent His Son and the world killed the Son. But the Son did not remain in the tomb! Oh! No, He arose and began the work of gathering all things unto Himself. *“Having made known unto us (His saints, His separated ones) the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself: That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one ALL THINGS IN CHRIST, both which are in heaven (unseen realm) and which are on earth; even in him.”* (Eph.1: 9-10)

The world is not aware of what is about to take place, but within the hearts of man dwells a hope of better things. The world believes that they can someday achieve peace on earth by their own devices; this is a great deception. When they come to the end of themselves, they will find that what they have been travailing and groaning for has just appeared; even the manifestation of the sons of God.

When this happens, Satan, the deceiver and master liar will be bound for a thousand years according to God's calendar. During that time, all who had come against the truth and believed the lie will be delivered by the Word made flesh in the sons. This is a time of great restoration in the world. The sons of

God will take their place as kings and priests and reign with Christ in the earth.

But there will still be multitudes who remain in darkness. They are the people whose number is as the sand of the sea. They have set their hearts against the true God and they hold a deep-seated hatred for all that is called Christian or Jew. They are dealt with when Satan is loosed again and leads these nations to unleash their fury on the four quarters of the earth and to gather them to make war against the city and the people of God.

Only now the deceiver is in for a shock. *“And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.”* (Rev.20:9) God had gathered them into one place to consume them by fire.

God has chosen His Son to rule and reign in the world and He will fully consume all that is of the deceiver by fire. He has done this in us and will finish the work in the earth. God had promised Abraham, *“And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.”* (Gen.22: 18) *“Arise, O God: judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit ALL NATIONS.”* (Ps. 82: 8) Christ is gathering all things unto Himself. LET NOT YOUR HEART BE TROUBLED.

“And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.” (Rev.20: 10)

There is a refining fire of God for the people, and there is a consuming fire of God for the devil. The false prophet is not one man because there have been many false prophets in the world. This false prophet is the spirit of the false prophets that worked in these men. Just like the Antichrist is not one man, but is the spirit that is the counterfeit of Christ.

The devil is not an actual serpent; it is the spirit of the deceiver that has been at work in the world. And the beast is the beastly nature of the first Adam man. Jesus had him nailed to the cross and in His

resurrection He became his replacement forever. So we find the foe in the lake of fire. LET NOT YOUR HEARTS BE TROUBLED...BELIEVE.

Most of us have read all this in the book of Revelation, yet we have thought that it was always for later. Today, if we hear by the Spirit we understand that indeed many of these events are in place; the stage has been prepared, many of these things have already begun.

The Word made flesh in the sons of God opens the door to the great restitution that is promised by the mouth of all God's prophets. Isaiah saw the kingdom of God coming to earth. He wrote to the church, "*Sing, O barren, thou that didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou that didst not travail with child: for more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the Lord.*" (Isa.54:1) Indeed the true bride has been barren. The one who is seen in the world has many children but the true bride has been waiting to bring forth.

She will bring forth many children from the nations everywhere. The prophet declares that she will inherit the Gentiles! So "*Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: Spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes; For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left; and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.*" (Isa.54: 2-3)

Who is the seed of the the barren church but the Word made flesh in the sons. Who are those who will make the desolate cities to be inhabited but the sons who rule with Christ?

And the prophet exhorts, "*Fear not; for thou shalt not be ashamed: neither be thou confounded; for thou shalt not be put to shame: for thou shalt forget the shame of thy youth, and shalt not remember the reproach of thy widowhood any more.*" (Vs.4) Be not afraid to enlarge thy tent. Do not be afraid to embrace the word of truth. Be not afraid of the deceiver but fear only God.

Many Christians today are fearful when they hear a

word that has been shunned in the past. There was a time when we heard a word that witnessed to our spirits and we embraced it fully even when it meant being put to shame by those who were once our friends. But now many are afraid to continue on. They have built their spiritual houses and are satisfied with what they have found.

Yet the prophet is clear. The barren is exhorted to enlarge her tent and fear not. She will not be put to shame. "*For thy Maker is thine husband; the Lord of hosts is his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; **the God of the whole earth** shall he be called. For the Lord hath called thee as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when thou wast refused, saith thy God.*" (Vs.5-6)

Note the words of the prophet: "The Holy One of Israel (the Christ) shall be called the God of the whole earth." Up to that time, He is known only as the God of Israel but after the coming of the sons of God, He becomes the GOD OF THE WHOLE EARTH! God all in all! As spoken by the voice of all His prophets.

This is when He (the Son) has put all things under Him and the last enemy which is death is destroyed. "*For he must reign, till he hath put all put all enemies under his feet, the last enemy that shall be destroyed is death...And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.*" (I Cor. 15: 25,26,28)

This is the work of the sons of God in Christ. They are Christ's ambassadors to creation. By overcoming death they inherit the Gentiles. What a mission. This is the purpose of Jesus Christ in the sons.

Later we see that even those who have stood against God will no longer do that. The fire of God will devour all that is not of Him. The beast which speaks of the beastly nature of the Adam man and the "false prophet" which is the Lie of the serpent nature and the devil who is the brain of the prince of the air, all have their place in the lake of fire and brimstone. They will no longer appear on the earth.

BELIEVE ALSO IN ME

“YE BELIEVE IN GOD, BELIEVE ALSO IN ME.” (Jn.14: 1) This seems so simple and yet it is so hard. These words carry such a depth of meaning for us all. We may declare, “Lord you know I believe” but let us take Paul's advice and *“Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?”* (II Cor. 13: 5).

“PROVE YOUR OWN SELVES HOW THAT JESUS CHRIST IS IN YOU.” Have we proven to ourselves that Jesus Christ is indeed in us and that He speaks to us daily. Do we really believe that He dwells in us and that His Spirit of truth is leading us into all truth and will not let us fall into error?

We may say yes we do, but how many of us really pay attention to the small voice that comes in the breeze (spirit) of the day and gently drops a word in our heart? How many really believe that a dream may indeed be a Word that the Lord had dropped in the mailbox of our spirits? And how many earnestly seek the correct interpretation from the Spirit?

Each word that Jesus speaks to us is spirit and life and it is a revelation of Himself. He is revealing Himself to us and in us. He is exposing the lies that the old “us” have been trained to believe as truth. Yes, we believe in God. We believe that there is a God, we even believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, but have we come to accept that He dwells in us by the Spirit and that He is alive and speaking to us?

Jesus ascended to the Father and He is taking us up to be one with Him and the Father. Jesus taught us to call God “our Father”. How many religions in the world call their God Father? Jesus said, *“I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.”* (Jn.20: 17b) Jesus referred to God as Father many times, and he called Him “Your Father” many times as well. This is the God we believe in. He is our Father...but we can only go to the Father in the Son...And the Son is leading us there by His Spirit. “YOU BELIEVE IN GOD, BELIEVE ALSO IN ME.”

Note that in the dream, I was given the opening words to the message and I was told that the Spirit would give me the rest as I spoke. This is a very important clue. The Spirit never reveals the truth to us all at once, He reveals it as we go because each revelation changes us, *“But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.”* (II Cor. 3: 18)

The word that He has opened up to us since that time has certainly been life-changing. There was a time when we beheld the Lord in the imaginations of our minds but now we behold Him in His Word of truth. We no longer see Him as in a glass (mirror) darkly; we behold Him each time He reveals Himself to us by His Word of truth. When He has fully revealed Himself to us, we will see Him as He is and we will be like Him. *“When he shall appear we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. And every man who has this hope in him purifieth himself even as he is pure.”* (I Jn. 3: 2b-3)

A REBELLIOUS NATION

When God sent Ezekiel to speak to the house of Israel, He warned him, *“I send thee to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that hath rebelled against me...For they are impudent children and stiffhearted. I do send thee unto them; and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God.*

*And they whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear (for they are a rebellious house) yet shall know that there hath been a prophet among them.. And thou son of man, **be not afraid of them, neither be afraid of their word, though briers and thorns be with thee, and thou dwell among scorpions: be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they be a rebellious house.**”* (Eze. 2: 3a, 4-6)

From the time of Israel of old to our very day, all of God's people, as long as they are children have rebelled against God's discipline. It is only when one has walked with the Lord and has been chastised by His hand that one matures and is changed from stubborn and rebellious to a believing and submitted son.

It is written in the prophets, *“Is not my word like as a fire? Saith the Lord; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?”* (Jer.29: 23) The word that God sends is stronger than our hearts of stone.

As long as we are still children in the Lord, we are to submit to the ministries that the Lord has given to us. The purpose of any true ministry is to bring one to Christ and not to themselves. As these ministries teach us we begin to hear His word ourselves and we find that we are more and more dependent on the Spirit within and less on man's ministries.

A ministry can only take us to the place where they themselves spiritually abide. However each one has a place in the Lord and the Spirit will lead each one to find the place reserved for them in Christ. This reminds me of the story of the young eagle that had to be thrown out of the cozy nest. At first the eagle fell and the mother had to scoop it back up into the nest. But as she kept pushing him again and again out of the nest, he exercised his wings and finally was able to fly on his own. It is a fearful thing to go through but it has to be for each one who is called in Christ. After many trials we have learned to trust in the strength of His wings. We have no doubt that they will take us on to the truth that makes us free.

GOING TO FATHER'S HOUSE

In my previous writing I shared my dream about being in Paris and going to my Father's house. This is the second such dream that I had about finding my Father's house. The first dream was several years ago and in it my father lived *“Rue des Etres”* (street of the beings). In this recent dream, He lived *“Rue des Chretiens.”* (street of the Christians).

Jesus said, *“In my Father's house are many mansions (abiding places) if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go to prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.”* (Jn.14: 2-3)

Jesus was not going to hire masons and carpenters to build us houses in the sweet by and by, He was going to the Father so that we could receive His

Holy Spirit and abide in the highest place in Christ.

In Father's house there are many abiding places, many dimensions of life. Jesus wants us to be where He is in the Father. This is the dimension of the sons. As we have walked with the Lord since our conversion, we have dwelt in various dimensions of Spirit. However, Jesus wants us to be where He is and He has prepared the place for us.

The abiding place of the Son is higher than any other. The higher we are, the more we see. When astronauts get up as high as they can in their shuttle they can see the beautiful whole earth as the blue marble spinning happily in the blue atmosphere. It is an awesome sight. At night, the populated continents are all lit up with millions of twinkling lights. Down here on earth, we only see what is in front of us and we have no idea of where we are in space. God created a wonderful world but most of us can only see a smidgen. The higher we go in Spirit, the more we see and the more we know God. We can know God as creator, or as Lawmaker or as Saviour but it is when we know Him as Father that we enter the highest and holiest realm of the Son.

To know the Father is not to know about Him; it is to be one with Him; it is to think His thoughts and move in His ways. This is the place that Jesus has prepared for us and that His Spirit is leading us to. We have reached the place of Spirit (we are in Paris, the city of light), we know the Father's address, we have been given much revelation, but we still must follow the Holy Spirit who really knows the way to get there. We are not quite there yet...at least I am not.

We ask the same question that Thomas asked, *“Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?”* (Vs.5) Indeed in my dream, I did not know the way but there was a young man who knew all the twists and turns of every street and who was leading me there. So it is that Jesus has given us His Spirit of truth to lead us to the Father's house. He knows all the twists and turns of the ways to get there and we can trust Him fully.

Jesus informed Thomas of the only way to go to the Father. *“I am the way, the truth and the life: no*

man cometh to the Father but by me.” (Vs.6) Knowledge of the Scriptures is good but it will not do it. Other gods cannot bring us there. Going to church and conventions regularly will refresh us and stir the Spirit within us but it cannot take us to Father. Only as we walk daily with Jesus by the Spirit are we entering Father's house and eternal life.

A REMARKABLE INTRODUCTION

Introducing His Father, Jesus continued, *“If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also; and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him. Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? He that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?”* (Jn.14: 7-9)

The Father is Spirit, and the Son is the image of the Father. So when we know the Son, we know the Father. However, it is one thing to know Him and another to be as He is or to abide in Him. This is where the Spirit is taking us. He has introduced us to our Father, we have found Him in us and now we are entering in Him. We are His house and He is ours. What a journey!

The Old Testament introduced us to a God of power and law. This God has not changed. He rules the world with power and law, but when He becomes our Father through Jesus Christ, He becomes the God of grace and truth. *“And the word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and as of the only begotten of the Father) FULL OF GRACE AND TRUTH.”* (Jn.1: 14)

God does not change, as the God of the Old Testament, as the creator, as the God who rules the universe and even as the God that rules in the affairs of men, He is a fearful God. But Jesus came to bring us to the Father. This is a side of God that is available to the sons. Jesus saves us from the curse of the Law, He saves us from the fury of an angry, fearful God and brings us to the all forgiving Father.

In Christ, we are reconciled to God and we have

been given the ministry of reconciliation. *“All things are of God who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; to wit, that God was in Christ reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.”* (II Cor.5: 18-19)

Paul knew the Word by the Spirit and he made it clear. He had been a Pharisee and knew the Scriptures. He knew the God of the Old Testament but on the road to Damascus, He met up with the Son and the Son led Him to the Father. The Son reveals the Father and His Spirit leads us to abide in Him. We are entering Father's house.
