### THE ABSOLUTE PROMISE OF THE FATHER

*“And behold, I send the **promise of my Father** upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.”* (Lk.24: 49)  
The promise of the Father that Jesus sent to His first disciples and passed on to us through the centuries, holds treasures beyond compare and riches past any measure. Jesus told the disciples,

It is the same promise that was first given to Abraham when he willingly offered up his only son Isaac on Mt. Moriah, only now it could be received in its fulness. *“...By myself have I sworn, saith the Lord, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son: that in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying, I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies; And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.”* (Gen.22: 16-18)

We read this promise anew in the New Testament, *“For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he swore by himself, Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee. And so after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.”* (Heb. 13-15)

The absolute promise of God is not only written in the Scriptures, it was engraved in the heart of Abraham the day he offered his beloved only son Isaac for he knew that even if God required the life

of Isaac at his hand, He was able to raise him from the dead. God's promise to Abraham and to us is the gift of the Christ in RESURRECTION LIFE. *“By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac; and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, of whom it was said that in Isaac shall thy seed be called: accounting that God was able to raise him from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.”* (Heb. 11: 17-19)

This same promise was written upon the heart of the only begotten Son Jesus who knew that as He laid His life down unto death, the Father would raise Him up again. And the same promise of being raised from the dead is also given to the Seed of Abraham which is Christ in you the hope of glory. The Father has sworn this by an oath and He will not fail.

We are told, *“Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, and to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed; which is Christ.”* (Gal.3: 16) We know that Jesus *“...took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.”* (Heb.2: 16)

Seeds are the way that God has given to reproduce life in the earth. So seeds are extremely important. In botany we learn that seeds hold the entire life of plants and trees in the earth. There has been human manipulation of seeds and we have plants that are a mixture of several seeds; they are hybrids. The carnal minds of men have tried to manipulate man's

DNA as well and religious spirits have sought to mix doctrines of devils to confuse the pure Word of God, but the Seed of Christ that holds the glory of resurrection life remains forever pure.

God has always protected the Seed that He gave to Abraham. He carefully chose the wombs who would nurture it, from Sarah to the young virgin Mary who gave birth to the flesh body of Jesus. Mary was impregnated by the Holy Spirit and not by man, but the seed that formed the body of Jesus came through the genealogies all the way from Abraham.

Therefore when Jesus walked the earth, His body was of the seed of Abraham, the seed of David. The seed was preserved all the way to Mary, by those who were called to that purpose. *“Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; and declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.”* (Rom.1: 3-4)

*“For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.”*(Heb.2: 16) So we see that the Seed of Christ came down through the genealogies from Abraham to Christ.

When Jesus told the disciples that He was going to send them the promise of the Father, He was talking about the Seed that contains the body of resurrection. The prophet declared, *“And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha.”* (Rom.9:29) The Seed in the earth is what has kept flesh from being completely destroyed, even as Sodom and Gomorrah.

The Seed which is Christ had to come through the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus so that it includes the body of resurrection that He obtained for Himself and for us at Calvary. He is the Savior of the body. *“For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the Saviour of the body.”* (Eph.5: 23)

In my previous study I wrote that when Jesus told Mary Magdalene *“Touch Me not for I am not yet ascended to my Father...”* (Jn.20:17a) He was ready to present His body of glory to the Father so that the seed that He sent His disciples included that same body of resurrection. Jesus' sacrifice had to first be received by the Father just as the blood sacrifice of the High Priest had to first be received for the sins of the people. (Heb.9: 7-8) This is what Jesus meant when He told them, *“I go to prepare a place for you.”* (Jn.14: 2b)

Abraham followed God by faith. He was not under the Law of Moses for he was before Moses. He is the image of the one who walks by faith and follows God. When God told Abram, *“Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee...”*(Gen.12: 1) Abram did not hesitate. He packed up his stuff and left. *“...he obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.”* (Heb.11: 8b)

God took Abraham through many hard tests but the acid test was when He asked him to offer up his beloved son Isaac; Abraham obeyed. He obeyed because he trusted God and he knew that if he had to go all the way with the offering, God was able to raise Isaac back from the dead. Because of this perfect trust and obedience Abraham received the promise of the seed that would bless and deliver the nations (heathens) of the world.

This promise is sealed by an oath. *“For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater; he sware by himself...”* (Heb.6: 13) When men take an oath they swear by the Bible because it is the Word of God and it is greater than themselves. But God is the Highest therefore He had to swear by Himself. He did this when He raised Jesus from the dead. He gave proof of His power and integrity as He raised His own Son back to glory.

Just as Abraham offered His only begotten son Isaac, so the Father gave His only begotten Son Jesus and just as in a figure Isaac was raised from the dead, so the Only Begotten Son of God was raised

from the dead. This is the seal of the promise. This is the way God swore by Himself. He gave His only Son and raised Him from the dead.

We also read, *“But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.”* (Rom.8: 11) That same promise is to all in whom God' Spirit dwells.

When Jesus told the disciples to tarry in Jerusalem to receive the promise of the Father, He was talking about that very promise. The promise of receiving power from on high- Power that would take them all the way to resurrection life.

What they received was the Holy Ghost. It was the Lord Himself in Spirit form. It was the Lord Himself in the form of a new seed that would grow in these earthen vessels and raise them into new life- His life. *“Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you except ye be reprobates?”* (II Cor.13: 5b) It is the fulness of Jesus Christ who dwells within by the Spirit. He is that new Seed in us and it is His fulness that is arising from the midst of us.

*“But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God and not of us.”* (II Cor.4: 7) The treasure is a mystery. It is not known by the natural understanding. It is *“Christ in you the hope of glory.”* (Col.1: 27b)

## DIGGING FOR THE TREASURE

I once had a dream that the Lord keeps bringing back to me because it is an ongoing event. In the dream, *“I looked out of my living room window and saw a couple of neighbors digging up my front yard. They were vigorously and effectively digging large slabs with engraved writings on them and arranging them neatly into piles. I went out and found that they had dug many and there were piles of these engraved slabs all over the back yard as well.”* End of dream.

Indeed there are many today who have found the

mystery of Christ within and they are digging to find the treasures that have been hid for ages. These treasures are the purposes and laws of God that are engraved on the tables of our very hearts. But we have to dig for them.

Indeed we have been digging for them in every way that we have known. We have been to meetings where certain ones have been able to bring out some of these hidden truths which have become the foundations upon which we have been building the true temple by the Spirit. We have been digging by reading books and literature of all kinds until we find the ones that truly witness to our spirits and become life to us. We dig within each other as God reveals Himself to us through every word spoken that comes from His mouth. *“It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.”* (Matt.4: 4)

Well did the Lord say, *“Seek and ye shall find..”* And the wise king wrote, *“It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out the matter.”* (Prov.25: 2) For this reason, many books have been written and many studies have been made for us to dig and find the concealed treasures that God in His wisdom has hid right within us. The books and the studies are not to fill us with knowledge; they are to stir up the spirit of revelation from within.

In digging, we have all made errors along the way. I believe these are mostly errors in interpretation but nevertheless errors exist among us. Yet we should not fret ourselves about them as Paul declared that if any man builds on the foundation with things of the flesh, there would come a day in which these things would be burnt up. *“Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver and precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.”* (I Cor. 3: 12-13)

This is a safeguard for us all. Every word or work that we lay on the foundation is tested by fire. That which is of the flesh and not of God will be re-

vealed by fire. This means that the moment it is revealed as false, it is burnt up. If we cling to our errors we will suffer great loss. We may believe that this will happen on a future day and that is certain too. But if we yield ourselves to God's daily correction, He will burn up the errors quickly.

This also applies to the false doctrines that we may embrace along the way. If, as soon as the Spirit reveals them to us we yield ourselves to the truth, they will be burnt up with less damage to us. We know that this has already happened many times in our lives.

Paul continues on the subject and shows that this is often a painful experience but it keeps us in the way of salvation. *"If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss; but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire."* (Vs.15)

Paul also says this, *"For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord. Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God."* (I Cor.4: 4-5)

We may think that we are waiting until a future day when the Lord appears to judge our hearts and make manifest the false doctrines and works of darkness but I have found that the Lord comes to judge and correct His children much sooner than that.

He has come to shine His bright light of truth upon our darkness many times over. For me, He has often come in a dream and there were times when I did not want to accept that dream or remember it. But because of His love, He did not let me forget it and worked in a way that I could not deny.

The Lord comes to each one to deal with our hearts and minds as only He knows. Often, we turn the other way and we suffer the consequences too. He is a Father who loves His children and disciplines them. He comes as the Bridegroom who is in love with His bride and is sanctifying and cleansing her for the wonderful day of their full union.

Paul explains, *"For there must be also heresies among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you."* (I Cor.11:19) Heresies are "opinions or doctrines at variance with the accepted creed." Paul says that there needs to be various doctrines and opinions so that we can know the ones which are approved of God.

This does not mean that the accepted ones are the approved ones or that they do not need to be revised. It means that we should not quench those that disagree with our comfortable ways because God uses them to manifest the truth among us. This is a way for us to grow. There are many well meaning brethren who are so fearful of deception that they stoically stand in their doctrines and grow no more. They are among the fearful and unbelieving that stand outside of the City.

And so we vigorously dig for the treasures in the Christ within and we know that the God who looks upon our hearts will not allow us to remain deceived in any way. Deception is the result of a heart that has the wrong motives. Jeremiah warned, *"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?"* (Jer.17: 9)

God deals strongly with our hearts each day. In our deception we think that we have the right motives or reasons to do things, when in reality they are the works of our fleshy hearts. Often we deceive ourselves into thinking we are doing the works of God when we are just helping to promote more of the works of Babylon in the earth.

In His love and mercy, our Father deals with the pride that could puff us up as we acquire more knowledge and clout in the Word. It was so for the apostle Paul and he explained, *"For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me to be, or that he heareth of me."*

*And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above*

*measure. For this I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee; for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.” (II Cor. 12: 6-9)*

These are powerful words of comfort indeed. Now we must not believe that all infirmities are used of God to keep us from being puffed up, but there are what Paul called “thorns in the flesh” which come from Satan to buffet us and keep us from feeling we are so smart. All of us I am sure have suffered from an actual thorn in the flesh and we know that they really hurt and can even fester if they are not dealt with.

Paul had great revelations so to keep him from getting puffed up, God kept him helpless to help his body recover from a certain affliction. Recently, I had an experience that brought this home to me. It began with a dream that seemed to be one of those many insignificant dreams that somehow stayed in the back of my mind.

Several days later I found myself in a situation where I severely twisted my back. I did not feel it until the next day, but when I did, I knew that this was going to be painful for a while. I did the usual things to help myself. I prayed, I rubbed, I took Aleve and applied heat and I waited. Then about the third day I was laying flat on my back when I decided to exercise my legs like riding a bicycle. It was then that the dream came back to me. That little short dream was going to open my understanding to what God was taking me through.

In the dream *“I was riding my little tricycle. It had a large front wheel with a very fat inflated tire. All of a sudden, the front tire blew with a loud noise. I could go no farther. I stood and saw that I was in front of a large shop that fixed bicycles and tricycles. A neighbor was standing behind me. He was doing nothing only he was there behind me.”* End of dream-

I had not paid much attention to that dream because at the time it made no sense to me. But as I

laid flat on my back “bicycling” my legs in the air, I realized that it was my answer. My tricycle was broken down. My hip joints were hurting. I sought the Lord about the shop that would fix it and called the neighbor that was standing in the dream. I asked him, *“Did you ever hurt your back?”* He said *“Yes once and had to go to the emergency room. They sent me to a chiropractor who fixed it in just a few adjustments.”*

Then I told him about my back and with no hesitation he said, *“Jackie, I will take you to this doctor. He is a little ways and not easy to find so I will take you the first time.”* I knew that this was what the dream was about and I went and the doctor did help me a lot.

So I thank the Lord for the way He guided me through this, but it was not over. I still have some lingering pain in my hips and even though I know that all will be well, the Lord had something more to speak to me in this dream. The problem with my tricycle began when the front very inflated tire blew up!!! I then understood that He was zeroing in on my ego... What caused the whole problem is that the Lord was dealing with my inflated ego.

I prayed and listened closely to the still small voice of the Lord. By the Spirit, I came to realize that although I had never thought of myself as “prideful,” I indeed had areas where I was quite proud of myself. I was thankful for my physical good health but at the same time I was quite proud of it too! I was proud of my strength, my good hearing and eyesight and of all the things I can still do at my age. I am blessed in many ways...and I do thank the Lord for it every day...yet down deep, the Lord saw the pride of this creature.

My front wheel was very inflated...and something had to be done. I did that all by myself when I twisted my body out of an overstuffed chair and strained my back. My Father did not rescue me. He let me feel the full brunt of it. I was flat on my back and not feeling so strong after all. It was time for a good buffeting from the Father who disciplines His sons yet He did it with so much love and mercy.

It is not easy for me to write this but I know that

the Lord wants us to be vulnerable so that others can benefit from our personal lessons; God has designed it this way. We are all in the school of life so that we can quickly learn to discern the works of the flesh and face them in the light of truth.

It is God's love that uses all things to our good, even our hurts. It is often the way He brings us to our knees and changes our hearts. These are all the inworkings of the Spirit. He first gives us the glorious revelations. He first brings us to know who we are in Christ so that when we go through the fire we do not faint. It is easier to go through the fire when we see the reward.

### MEASURING THE TEMPLE

As humans we always like to compare ourselves to others who are weaker than us. But the Lord is measuring us according to His standard. A standard is an approved measure; Christ is the Standard. This is not speaking of behavior only, it is speaking of substance. We are not measured according to our behavior in comparison to His; we are measured according to who we are in Him.

Of course behavior follows but our identity or character controls our behavior and not the other way around. With much will power we can make ourselves behave well, but sooner or later our true image will appear.

John wrote, *“And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.”* (Rev.11: 1)

The angel of the Lord gave John the command. He is the Spirit of the Lord that speaks to us daily. He gave John a reed and told him to rise and start measuring the temple. To measure is to compare the quantity or quality of a thing by the standard given. This is the temple of God and so the standard of measure is Christ.

The final temple of God is the Body of Christ. Along the way, God had directed that His dwelling place be built by man's hand, such as the Tabernacle

of Moses and the temple that Solomon built. When Jesus came to earth, He was the only habitation of God by the Spirit; He was the true temple of God. Since then, He has been building His people into a holy temple and so the Body of Christ is the only temple or habitation of God in earth. He said that He would build it in three days. These are thousand year days on God's calendar.

God is omnipresent spirit and is everywhere, but He reveals Himself and speaks to men from His temple. The time is upon us when the temple or Body of Christ must come to its fulness or perfection. The angel told John to measure that temple to assess how much longer it would take for it to come to the full stature of the measure of Christ which is its maturity or perfection.

It is no mistake or coincidence that the next verses have to do with the two witnesses and their testimony for it is when their testimony is finished that the true temple of God will be seen opened in heaven. *“And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in the temple the ark of the testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.”* (Vs.19)

We know that John was caught up in the Spirit. What He saw was not in our “time zone.” He saw things as they are in the end. He saw the temple fully open in the realm of Spirit and what he saw revealed one thing, “The Ark of The Covenant.” In the end, the Ark is the only thing found in the open temple of God. The Ark was a wooden box overlaid inside and outside with pure gold. This Ark is the Body of Christ in its glory.

Wood speaks of flesh and gold speaks of the pure nature of God. It is man overlaid inside and out with God's nature. It is the new creation of God in Christ. When the temple of God is opened, the Ark is the only thing we see. There are no more services in the temple. The Holy Place is gone and only the Holy of Holies with the Ark remains. Only the Presence of God in His new creation in Christ remains. Oh! Yes the Mercy Seat is very much part of it. It is a thick slab of pure gold. Well did the Psalmist de-

clare, *“Praise ye the Lord, O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.”* (Ps.106:1)

## THE TWO WITNESSES

To come to the day of the open temple, those who worship therein have to be measured. This is the time of the two witnesses. We know that Jesus is the head of that witness company. He said that He did nothing of Himself but that the Father in Him did all the works. Jesus gave witness of the Father. The Father and the Son, the Spirit and the Word are the two witnesses. Jesus first came to His own people Israel, but He was not received- They crucified Him. He was one of the witnesses who was killed for the Word of God.

Then comes the company of witnesses who are filled with His Holy Spirit. All of them are witnesses of Jesus come in the flesh. They are witnesses of the Father too. All who are called to this company must finish their testimony, all must stand for the Word that is given to them by the Spirit, and all must be killed. *“And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them and kill them.”* (Vs.7)

This is what happened to our Lord Jesus and we know that it has also happened to many of His disciples. Let me assure you that this is also what happened to His apostles and prophets ever since and still. And this is all God's plan. God has purposed that the evil religious nature that has usurped the place of Christ must reveal itself by viciously coming against the Christ of God.

In my small but very real and personal way, I have found this to be true. A few years after the Lord called me to this walk, I had my first experience with this. God showed me my calling in a dream. I have written this dream several times already so I will now mention only its meaning.

The Lord was showing me that the church that we know in the world is like unto professional dancers who have assumed a high position over the people

of God. They are no more than professional performers who have lost their union with the true Spirit of God. As much as they try to retrieve it; they cannot.

Then the dream showed that the Lord had called a remnant of people, to bring back the true Word of God in due season. In the dream I was baking an apple pie out of the waters of the swift running river. Apples speak of the Word of God fitly spoken and in due season. *“A word fitly spoken and in due season is as apples of gold in pictures of silver.”* (Prov.25: 11) The dream goes on to show that when such word is offered to the leaders and performers of the church, they are furious and turn against those who offer them the Word of truth.

Indeed this dream came to pass for the first time in my life when my husband and I shared it with our pastor. This man was a scholar in the Scriptures. My husband and I were shocked when he became furious and demanded that we immediately turn in our letter of resignation. This was the first time we were killed for the Word and it was not the end.

Then my husband and I became part of a group of His called out people. They too had been called out of their denominations and seven days a week we would gather to hear the Word that came through teachings and through dreams and visions. God continued to speak to me and others in the group through prophetic dreams that usually came to pass with no delay. Several years later, the dream that God had given me at first was about to come to pass again. As the years went by and God sent many preachers and teachers our way, that first dream was repeated over and over again.

The beast that has been quietly laying at the bottom of the pit is the serpent that is hiding in all the rites and rituals that men conjure up in the name of God. It has to be exposed. These things are all false witnesses and God has called His prophets and apostles to lay their lives down to reveal the truth.

The first two witnesses were Jesus and the Father in Him. The same two witnesses are within the Body of His called out people. Jesus' ministry in the

earth was three and a half years. Symbolically the ministry of His witness company is fulfilling the remaining three and a half years until it completes seven symbolic years. *“They shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.”* (Rev.11: 3b) Note they are in bodies of mourning (sackcloth)-

The word that we have been given is powerful. It has the power to bring many woes upon the “religious” flesh that has been in one accord with the old serpent. Saints of God rejoice! If you have been separated and scorned for your Word...have no fear. You are in Father's perfect will.

Later as I was still with the same group of called out Christians, God gave me this powerful dream showing me what was about to happen. In this dream, *“I am standing outside the gate of my backyard that opens on an area of bushes and trees like a park. I see a beautiful child walking in the park. He is a young boy with eyes like deep pools of blue and curly blue hair that matched his eyes. Then I see a serpent coiled up near by. It's a huge rattle snake with its tail straight up ready to shake its rattle. I am told that the snake is that serpent of old. I know the snake is deadly and ready to strike the young child. Quick as a flash it happens. The child begins to run but I tell him to stay still and it will be easier. I look at him as he lay on his side and waits for death to come.”*

It actually took the unfolding of events in my life for me to understand that dream. I then realized that the child was the Word ministry that the Lord had given to me and to others in the same calling. Not long after the dream, the leader of the group had the revelation that they should branch out and settle themselves in isolated places that would be more secure in the future. The Lord sent His words of warning through me and various prophetic ministries but the leader was so sure he had heard from the Lord, he discarded all the words that came through the prophets. He quickly put his plan into action and worked to convince his followers to sell out and go live together in his proposed far away “wilderness” places.

When I pleaded with this leader and showed him

God's word he came strongly against me and saw to it that the words I gave him went no farther. The blue-haired boy had died. No I was not physically dead, but the ministry of the Word that I had been given for this group was gone. This was very painful for me at first, but now I know it was all ordained of God.

This is what happened and may still be happening to all who come with a pure word of God. The serpent must be revealed...and they must die. This is the way that the Lord has ordained for His witnesses and His prophets. Just as Jesus had to submit to those who nailed Him to the cross, we have to submit to the death that the Word brings us to. This is the death that we all suffer in order to be raised with Him in resurrection. This is why so many have ended up alone with nowhere to fellowship.

We read that after three and a half days the time is accomplished and *“..The Spirit of life from God entered into them (the witnesses) and they stood upon their feet and great fear fell upon them that saw them.”* (Vs.11)

I believe we are entering this phase in the times and purposes of God. We who have been laying dead in the streets (ways) of men. We who have been scorned and reviled for the word that He gave us are beginning to get our bearings. The two witnesses within us are arising again and we are being caught up to heaven (in God's presence). This means that we are coming into the place of Spirit where the enemies of truth can no longer reach.

Indeed the temple of God is being opened in heaven and the Ark of God is about to appear in the earth. The old Adam creation with all the systems that it has founded and established is being shaken. The Kingdom of our God is coming to rule and reign forever in the earth.

*“Our Father who art in heaven, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, in earth as it is in heaven.”* That which has been ruling in Spirit will now be fully come in earth. Amen!

Because of His love, *Jackie Caporaso*
