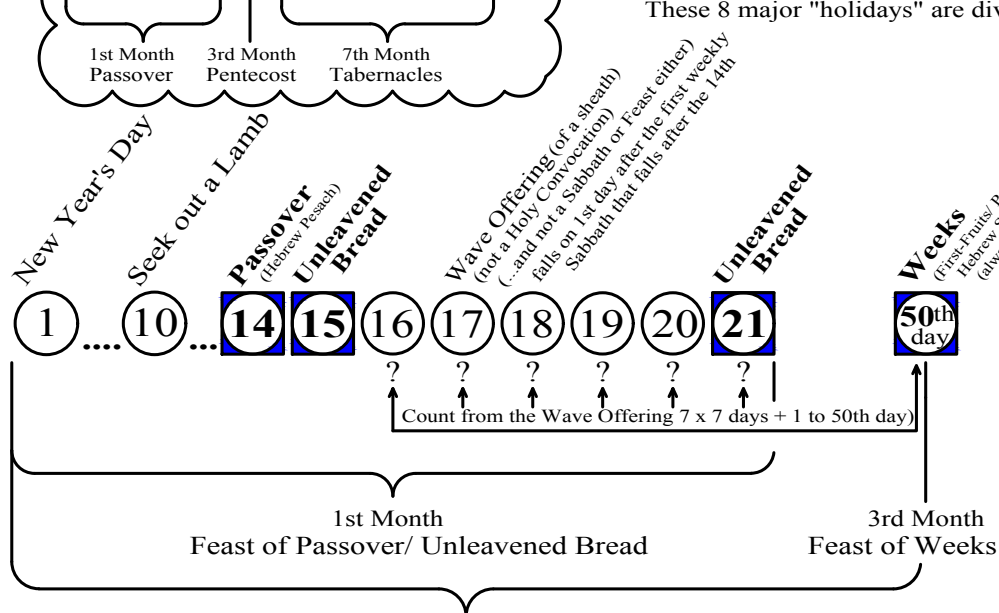
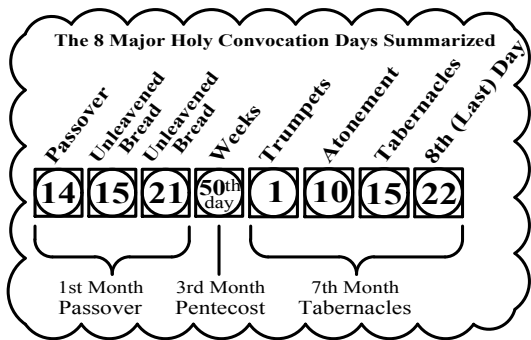


The 8 "Holy Convocation" Days

The days in *SQUARES* are the *ONLY* ones named in the scriptures as being "holy convocations";
 The days in just *CIRCLES* are days associated with the 8 holy convocations.
 "Holy convocation" is from the Hebrew "miqra quodesh", meaning "set-apart times for the called-out ones to assemble".

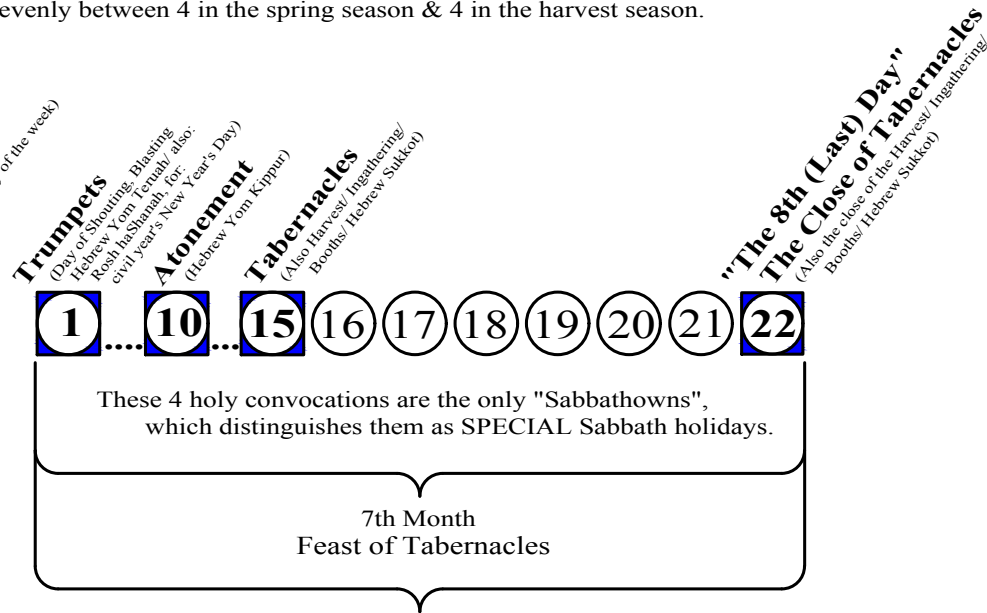
This is a timeline displaying the path of the righteous, the path through the sea, the path that no fowl knoweth.
 These 8 major "holidays" are divided evenly between 4 in the spring season & 4 in the harvest season.



Spring Feasts (time of the early rains)
1st Work of Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah as the Head
 (as King of kings & High Priest of priests)

The early harvest

Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah, the Head, fulfills one age and begins another age



Fall Feasts (time of the latter rains)

2nd Work of Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah as the Body
 (as the kings & priests submitted to The King & High Priest)

The final ingathering harvest (& when tares are separated from the harvest)

Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah unites His Body to fulfill one age and to begin another age
