A LEARNING EXPERIENCE

My personal saga continues, but perhaps it is not so personal. In my previous study, I shared with you my nearly two-year battle with a burning digestive system. These were the words that the Lord spoke to me at the time, *"You take care of the thoughts of your mind and I will take care of your body."* These bodies, with all their problems are useful tools in the Hand of our great Teacher.

They are the perfect earth furnaces that can bring us down to our knees, seeking only Him. It is through the fire that the truths that lead to eternal life are revealed in a real way. Our Father is not only teaching us to handle "spiritual warfare in His way; He is walking with us through it all.

Evidently, the personal lesson that I learned and shared with you in my previous writing, was not complete; there is more to follow. This time, this episode of learning opened even more understanding of all that is taking place in us. Although I do not relish writing about myself, and my personal life, sometimes it is by exposing the nitty-gritty details of our every day trials, that we not only edify one another, but also that we grow and come closer to our maturity or perfection in Christ.

In a nutshell, I am grateful for the life that my Father has given me. I had several life-threatening illnesses as a child; I came near death a few times. But throughout my adult life, I have been very healthy, with few, minor physical problems along the way. I have had severe trials, and have not been spared emotional suffering, but as the song goes, *"Through it all, I learned to trust in Jesus, and I learned to trust in God."* So I am very grateful for them all.

It was on December 12, 2019 that I awakened in awe of the striking scene I had been watching in my

sleep. (I shared it with my readers on the electronic list, and will include it at the end of this issue).

As the expression goes, I was "on cloud nine, but that same afternoon, a very sharp pain suddenly stabbed my left lower abdomen. At first, I doubled over but as it eased I figured it would soon go away, as often pains come and go. This kept up the rest of the night and by the next morning it was no better. I called my doctor's office who referred me to a doctor that could see me the same day.

After examining me, he said it was a good thing that I came quickly because I had an attack of diverticulitis. It was inflamed and most likely infected and I needed to take two strong antibiotics right away and go on a liquid diet. I told him about my sensitive stomach. He said if I cannot tolerate the antibiotics by mouth, I would have to go to the hospital and get them through IVs.

So I prayed earnestly, "Father, I need to overcome this, please give me the strength to do so." He was quick to answer, *"Of yourself, you cannot overcome this. But the time has come, when the son who is rising within you, will pass THIS test and bring you through."* This sounded familiar, yet there was something new about it. The Spirit was opening a whole new vista to my understanding.

We have fought many physical battles by faith. Jesus told a woman, *"Thy faith has made thee whole."* We have wrought many victories "by faith." But we are now coming to the times of the end, when the last enemy shall be destroyed. *"For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death."* (I Cor.15:25-26)

And death is not overcome by faith; DEATH IS OVERCOME BY LIFE. It is the new life within that

will swallow up the death of these bodies. *“So when this corruptible shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP IN VICTORY. O DEATH, WHERE IS THY STING? O GRAVE WHERE IS THY VICTORY?”* (I Cor:15:54-55)

The Spirit was telling me that what I was going through was a test of the new life in me. He took me through this trial with speed but only a few days later, I was facing the punch of a bad cold and cough. This time, I knew that I would be just fine. Through it all, I learned that this is the way that we will overcome death itself. As we are coming to the end of the age, not only do we see the world and all its systems falling apart, but we also experience the strength of the sons that are formed and arising within us.

This is the beginning of the manifestation of the sons of God. It is beginning with us and in us, and it is also beginning to show its power in the world. This is truly GOOD NEWS! Paul explains that we have been in an “in part” situation. The gifts of the Spirit, prophecy, tongues all shall cease and fail. *“For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.”*(I Cor.13:9-10) The time of our perfection in Christ has come. Thank you Father.

Now we can see that through all our trials and tribulation, our soul has been caught up in His life and has grown from babe to manhood. When His church began to form, this son within was as an embryo, with little overcoming strength. This is why from the time of Jesus’ resurrection, to now, even saints who have been stoic in the faith, have fallen to the grave when their bodies could not overcome the ravages of death.

But we are at the point, because He is arising in us, and because it is truly *“no longer I that liveth, but He that liveth,”* that the death in these bodies will have no more power over our very beings. Of ourselves, WE can never overcome death. It is He who is arising as a new mature Manchild, who is swallowing up the death in us. When I first set foot on this walk, sixty years ago, we had the vision and we heard the prophecies concerning this day. But now, we are coming to the possession of it all. No longer

should we see it all in the future, but the Day is at hand. He has confirmed this Word to our hearts many times in various ways and by the voice of many waters. WE BELIEVE. We have left behind the doctrines that taught us, and the time of our perfection in Christ is here and He is all we need. As it was in the days of Jesus’ resurrection, He is arising out of the tomb of these bodies. Hallelujah! He is alive forevermore.

Beloved saints of God, Paul saw this day but he knew it was not for his time. The complete church had to be formed. Paul fulfilled his part. Through the centuries since, saints have been called out of the world and the worldly systems. They have been joined to the invisible church of the Firstborn Son. They have been taught and trained by His own Hand, through the power of His Holy Spirit. And now, His little flock is standing ready to present His mighty work to the world. A brand new creation is about to be shown to the unsuspecting, yet expecting creation.

By the Spirit of holiness that dwelt in Him, Jesus overcame death in His body. He broke through the bonds of his tomb, and came up triumphant, forever waving and wielding the keys of hell and death for the world to follow. *“And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the RESURRECTION FROM THE DEAD.”* (Rom.1:4)

“I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive forevermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and death.” (Rev.1:18) There are no greater words than these. They are Spirit and they are life, and His breath of life is repeating them in our ear continually...Let us hear, listen and rejoice.

Yes, Jesus has been gathering, forming and preparing His church. He has washed her mind in the water of His Word. He has brought her to the point, where she can understand what He is revealing to her. She is being made “meet” for Him, her bridegroom. This is why we have come to this place of being so attracted to Him, (the Word of Truth). This is why our hearts and souls continue to Seek and search for Him. We have lost all interest in what the world at large is so enamored with. We, His church, have been prepared

to give birth. We have been impregnated with his Word of life. The Son within has now grown to strength. He will not be turned back.

The world still hates Him, and now vehemently rejects Him as His Body honors Him. But for us HE IS THE OVERCOMER and OUR ONLY LIFE. Truly, *“I am crucified with Christ; nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God who loved me, and gave himself for me.”* (Gal.2:20)

IT'S A LOVE AFFAIR

The entire work of redemption flows out of God's love for His creation. The very familiar verse that we love to quote, says it all. *“For God SO LOVED the world, (He loved the world so much), that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.”* (Jn.3:16-17)

A great hymn of the church chimes this truth to our hearts, *“Blessed assurance, Jesus is mine, O what a foretaste of glory divine...”* Indeed, the work of Jesus is our assurance, and the love of the Father who sent Him is the everlasting guarantee that this work cannot fail; it is perfect. It would be a shame and a sham if the Son's work to save the world just was not powerful enough to do a complete work. One may say, as I once did, that God gave man a “will of their own.” After all He was not creating puppets.

This is true in our daily lives; we make choices and reap accordingly. But the bottom line is that the will of our God is stronger than the will of man. I believe that God is truly as Peter wrote, *“The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, NOT WILLING THAT ANY SHOULD PERISH, BUT THAT ALL SHOULD COME TO REPENTANCE.”* (II Pet.3:9)

To come to repentance, they will surely suffer and be brought down to the pits, but they will not perish. Man would love to live this life forever, but he can-

not will himself to do so. God's will, supersedes man's will, always. The work of Jesus on the cross, supersedes the work of the serpent in the tree, (man's mind). In the end, it is to the glory of God, that every knee shall bow, and every tongue confess. *“For as it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.”* (Rom.14:11)

It is God's love that saves the world. Paul writes, *“BY GRACE are ye saved, through faith; and not of yourselves; it is the gift of God.”* (Eph.2:8) The grace of God is His love poured out to us. It is His grace that sent the Son, and His grace that saves us. Faith is given to us to grow spiritually, but it is God's grace that saves us. If our salvation depended on our faith, nobody would stand a chance. Faith works after we are saved by grace.

The mainstream churches believe that the majority of the population is doomed to hell, because they do not believe. The truth is that God BY HIS GRACE will ultimately bring all of them to repentance. It is because of God's grace poured out, that we first believe.

Paul writes, *“For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as GOD HATH DEALT TO EVERY MAN THE MEASURE OF FAITH.”* (Rom.12:3)

Our measure of faith increases as we see the Lord working in us through the fiery trials of this life. We may have to be tested through many fires, to be able to see the fourth Man, in the likeness of the Son of God, (the Christ man within), walking with us, as He did with the three Hebrews who were cast into Nebuchadnezzar's fiery furnace, heated seven times hotter. It was then that they were loosed from their bonds, and did not even smell like smoke.

Salvation is a gift, and the measure of faith that we received is a gift that increases by fire. Peter wrote, *“That the trial of your faith being much more precious than of gold that perishes, though it be tried by fire, might be found unto praise and honour and*

glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ.”(I Pet.1:7) These words are spoken to all Christians, but to His close disciples Jesus adds this, “*A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another, as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.*”(Jn.13:34-35)

Love is the bond that binds God and His creation together; and it is the bond of His love that binds us to one another. Nothing can take His love away from us. Paul knew this so well as he struggled against condemnation for having persecuted the church, “*For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depths, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*”(Rom.9:38-39)

Furthermore, John wrote, “*We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.*” (I Jn.3:14) John was not speaking only of our flesh and blood brotherhood; he was speaking of our brethren in Christ, all believers in Jesus. “*And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.*” (I Jn.3:23)

It is evident that in the body of Christ, we are closer to those that the Lord has set on our path, but I have found that, when we meet brethren that we had never seen before, we feel the same closeness right away, and the same love flows between us. It is not the proximity we have with one another that binds us; it is God’s love that unites us forever. I have no doubts that as we mature in Christ, and our hearts are changed, we will love all of God’s creation, even as He does.

And this love means A LOT. God will render the judgment, but love covers the sins. “*And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.*” (I Pet.4:8) The love that God has placed in our hearts for each other, is powerful indeed. Does this mean that we go around telling everyone we love them? Does it mean

that we agree with everything they do or believe? Not at all. But it means that we do them no harm. We do not judge them by the standard of our doctrinal beliefs, (Law). We wait for the Spirit of God to do His work in them, as He does in us. “*Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespassed against us.*”

There was a day, when I came against those that I thought did me harm. As I have moved in the revelation of Christ, and my vision has become clearer level by level, I now know that those whom I called “my enemies,” are indeed those who have helped me the most in my growth in Christ. At the same time, I was the enemy that helped them the most in their growth in Christ. Oh the wisdom of our God!

Now, I realize, that not only I must leave them be, but in my heart, I cannot hold a grudge against them. I know that what they did to me, they had to do. It was what God had prescribed for me. This is how the Spirit works in us to bring us to maturity. My first reactions were not very holy, but through it all, the flesh was being crucified. I am sharing this because I know that most of us have had experience in this area. Yet, what ever we thought was lost, will be restored many many times over, and in a better way.

Jesus knows us better than we know ourselves. He did not give us the commandment to love one another, without giving us the means to get to that place. He knew that it would not be easy to find love in our hearts for brethren who came mercilessly against us. He suffered the same and more. He had come to save His own, but it was His own who persecuted Him even unto death. He has suffered in every area that we suffer. The cross, is the way to find love and forgiveness in our hearts for others, and for ourselves as well.

And then there is another commandment that precedes this one. We cannot love one another without loving God. Jesus declared, “*The first of all commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength; this is the first commandment.*” (Mk.12:29-30).

The second, not less important, is to love others as ourselves. Jesus then said, “...*there is none other commandment greater than these.*” (Vs.31b)

THE HIDDEN BRIDE

The bride has great purpose in God’s plan. She is the vessel into which He plants His Seed. God’s seed is His Son, the Word of truth. But Eve, who was this first vessel, polluted herself with the seed of the serpent and lost God’s image. Since then, the Spirit of God has been searching for a bride who would produce that Son in the world. At first, God called the man whose heart was faithful, and He made a covenant with that man. In Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, God formed the nation into whom He could pour out His Word and bring forth a Son.

It was in that nation, Ancient Israel, that God, through Moses planted His Law and ordinances. If they kept His Law, they would live well, and God would make them strong and mighty. They would be an example to all the nations. “*There shall no man be able to stand before you: for the Lord your God shall lay the fear OF YOU upon all the land that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.*” (Deu.11:25)

When God sent Moses to face Pharaoh, He gave him this to say, “...*Thus saith the Lord, Israel is my son, my firstborn: And I say unto thee, Let my son go, that he may serve me; and if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, even thy firstborn.*” (Ex.4:22-23) Israel was God’s son and also his wife. Just as the bride of Jesus is also his wife and the sons.

As God’s wife, Israel did not keep herself pure before God. She polluted herself over and over again with the gods of this world, until God declared, “*And I saw, when for all the causes whereby, backsliding Israel committed adultery I had to put her away, and given her A BILL OF DIVORCE...*” (Jer.3:8a)

God was left with no earthly vessel to receive His Word and represent Him in creation. God spoke to His bride through prophets who gave their lives to bring her His Word. When she cried to Him, He

came to her rescue time and time again. He gave her many chances until He finally sent His Son in the flesh, and she rejected Him and crucified Him. The book of Hosea is the heart-wrenching story of the bride of God, and of Christ too.

God was not defeated, He appointed a new bride for the Son. He would find her among the Gentiles, on the “*highways and byways.*” God planned all this from the beginning. This bride was already chosen and tried and she was found faithful. She would not sell her soul to the world’s glamor and wealth. So God bought the WHOLE FIELD and He began to clear the land. He weeded it and burned the trash, but that was not all. He was looking for the treasure, the mystery that He had hidden down deep into the earth. It was a pearl of great price.

It is as an oyster is subjected to the constant irritation of a foreign substance, that it produces the nacre that forms the beautiful pearl. So the pearl of great price is formed in us, as the constant irritation of a foreign or enemy substance, constantly intrudes upon and challenges our soul. It is by resisting the foreign intruders of our soul, that the Christ, the most beautiful pearl is formed in us. It is through small and great sufferings in the flesh, that we are reborn, in Christ. He who knows the end from the beginning, had prepared the way for that pearl to be formed in us.

In his description of the city, John wrote, “*And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.*” (Rev.21:21)

When reading the Revelation, we must always keep in mind that everything in the book was spoken to John by symbols. It was “signified” or “communicated by an angel. It was given by pictures, to be understood in the language of the Spirit. None of it is a mixture. Jesus said, “*It is the spirit that gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.*” (Jn.6:63 NASB)

So we read that one of the seven angels talked to John saying, “...*Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb’s wife.*” (Rev.21:9) And so we are

not surprised when we read what happened next. *“And he carried my away in the spirit, to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God.”*(Vs.10)

To see this, John was transported in the Spirit, into the high domain of God’s great kingdom, (high mountain). It is through his spiritual vision that John was able to see this bride. And she was a great city, the holy Jerusalem. A city is a community where thousands or even millions of people live and work. Earthly cities are usually overcrowded, noisy and even dirty. But this was no earthly city, it was the HOLY JERUSALEM, the city called the Bride, the Lamb’s wife, who was formed in heaven by God. What John saw was the finished product that God had prepared from the beginning.

In an allegory, Paul makes a point. He speaks of Abraham’s two sons. He points out that the one was born of the bondwoman Agar and so was born after the flesh. *“But he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise.”* (Gal.4:23) So the Jerusalem that is formed in the world, continues to be after the flesh. *“But the Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all.”* (Vs.26)

The Jerusalem that John beheld by the Spirit, is not a city built by the world, or worldly materials. She is the one who has been formed by God Himself in the invisible realm of Spirit. She is the one that the angel called, the bride, the Lamb’s wife and the holy Jerusalem. And to enter that city, one has to go through the gates of pearl. One has to suffer many trials and constant irritations in the flesh.

The number twelve denotes “governmental perfection.” Twelve gates of pearl, tell us that we enter the city through submission to God’s perfect will. The city has twelve gates, all of pearl, so it can only be entered by those who, through suffering, have come to total submission to God’s perfect will. Those who have entered that city, have suffered with Christ in the flesh. *“If we suffer, we shall also reign with him; if we deny him, he also will deny us.”* (II Tim.2:12) Throughout the centuries, the true church of Jesus

Christ has been persecuted and suffered much, and it is through all these things that the city has been gathered. Being rejected and reviled for our Word is what we have in common. Today, denominational churches and various groups, are gathered together by their common creed or beliefs. Israel in the earth, gathers together because of their common ancestry. But the Church of Jesus Christ, His bride, His Holy City has this in common, she has fulfilled the sufferings of Christ in the flesh, and through it, she has been changed into His beauty, His likeness, His character.

Jesus told His suffering church, *“Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer; behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days; be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.”* (Rev.2:10)

There is an appointed time of tribulation that must be fulfilled by the church. Ten is the symbolic number of that kind of testing. In a recent dream, I saw myself walking on the road to the end of my journey. All my luggage and purse had disappeared, and I was handed ten dollars to finish the course. We are at the end of this journey, and all that is left now is for each one to fill up the cup of Christ’s sufferings. We will be rejected and reviled until He fully appears.

We take courage because He has revealed His purpose and reward unto us. When Jesus called each one to follow Him, He showed us the glory that was coming, but He did not right away reveal the suffering and fire that must come ahead of it. Little by little, He walked with us and taught us to deny the things that fed our outward man of the flesh. He also led us through spiritual warfare, and showed us our weaknesses and His power in our weaknesses.

His beloved city or bride, is made up of those who are called ACCORDING TO HIS PURPOSE. *“For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called; and whom he called, them he also justified; and whom he justified, them he also glorified.”* (Rom.8:29-30)

Many have claimed to be the church or the bride of Christ, but His bride does not sell her wares to the world. She does not give her gems to lovers who will use them for their own selfish gain and ambitions. She will not be manipulated by wolves in sheep's clothing such as the Jim and Tammy Faye Bakkers of the harlot, who blatantly made themselves rich and famous on the world scene, and did it in the name of His church. Watch out for those who offer a life of ease and wealth in this world, in exchange for your support of their ministries.

God had called a people, the nation Israel to be His bride in the world; He gave her the Law and ordinances to rule herself, and be the example to the nations of that day. She could not be faithful; she could not keep God's Law. Her purpose was to be the light of the world and to show forth God's glory to all the nations around her. She failed.

The bride, the church, is also a people, a city to whom God gave His Law, His Word. Only this time, His Law was not written on tables of stone. *"This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.* (Heb.10:16-17) She cannot fail.

JUST A THOUGHT ABOUT JERUSALEM

By the Spirit, the sweet Psalmist of Israel wrote, *"If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget her cunning. If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy."* (Ps.137:5-6) When Jesus came on the scene, His heart was turned toward Israel; He had come to redeem her. He knew that He was her last hope. His heart cried for her.

"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not! Behold, your house is left unto you desolate." (Matt.23:37-38) Even when we know that this is all in God's plan, it is a very difficult and painful time to go through. As history

records, Israel's desolation became more and more severe. Fierce enemies continue to push their way into Jerusalem, and desecrate her over and over again.

I am reading a book called "The Oracle," by Jonathan Cahn. God has given this man much insight and keen understanding of the words spoken by the prophets concerning Jerusalem. When I began to read, I did not feel interested because of the greater glory of the Jerusalem from above, that the Spirit has revealed to us and in us. But as I kept reading, I began to realize, that God has not totally forsaken these people.

They are God's first bride, the one under the covenant of the Law which is now null and void by reason of a better covenant. They are *"...the Jerusalem that now is, and is in bondage with her children."* Then the Spirit spoke this to my ear, *"They are for signs,"* I looked that up in the prophets and found, *"Behold, I and the children whom the Lord hath given me are for signs and for wonders in Israel from the Lord of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion."* (Isa.8:18)

And so in a very special way, Mr. Cahn has brought together the word of the prophets of old, with what is taking actually taking place in Israel today. The timing is perfect. This is happening because of the wonders that the Lord is working in His Jerusalem from above. We cannot be a light to them by joining their traditions; in Christ all things are new. Jerusalem that now is, is being restored, because the Holy City from above, is being set up to rule and reign in the earth. It is done by My Spirit, saith the Lord. God is writing His new covenant in their hearts. They will no longer be under the old covenant of Law, feasts and ordinances. The old is obsolete, replaced and signed in the blood of Jesus Christ.

It is because Jerusalem from above is coming into her time of appearing, that the restoration of Jerusalem that now is, is taking place in Israel. This is God's final Jubilee when all things must be restored. It is no coincidence that Mr. Trump has greatly desired to restore Jerusalem as the capital of Israel.

We know that the prophecies of old apply both literally and spiritually. The Word that is spoken by the Spirit, has to be fulfilled in the earth. So the children that are for a sign in Israel, is the nation that we see in the world today. What is happening to them is God working His wonder to bring them into the liberty of the children of God in Christ Jesus.

MY VISION OF DEC.12, 2019

This morning I woke up in awe of what I had just seen in my sleep. *“I was looking up in the sky and watching an airliner doing aerobatics. The nose of the plane reminded me of the shape of a bullet, but the rest was a silver and blue airliner. It was amazing how it would dive down and lose altitude, and then just pull up quickly, straight up vertically to climb higher very quickly. It kept doing this when I see another airliner, with a long sleek, elongated body, coming right where the first plane was flying. I thought Oh My! They are going to collide.*

Then the planes were coming closer to each other and it seemed that the first plane was being pulled, like by a vacuum force, toward the other airliner. Then its nose seemed to touch the other plane and be pulled with this strong vacuum force against it. It seemed to attach itself near the tail. As I looked, I thought that the bullet airliner was in trouble, and I realized that the sleek airliner was actually trying very hard to make it fall and crash.
